Byera Hadley Travelling Scholarships. Awarded since 1951

The Byera Hadley Travelling Scholarships are Australia's richest annual bequest for architecture. Since the first award in 1951, Byera's gift has supported travel and study by more than 160 students and architects

In 1937 Byera's Will provided for a scholarship that would allow recipients to travel and learn from the world. Byera Hadley, born in 1872, was a distinguished architect responsible for the design and execution of a number of fine buildings in New South Wales.

Byera began as a part-time teacher in architectural drawing at the Sydney Technical College - culminating in his appointment as Lecturer-in-Charge at the Department of Architecture in 1914. Under his leadership, the College became acknowledged as one of the finest schools of architecture in the British Empire of the time.

Byera Hadley made provision in his will for a bequest to enable young architects who were graduates from a school in NSW to travel overseas in order to broaden their experience in architecture, with a view to advancing architecture upon their return to Australia.

The first recipient of a Byera Hadley Travelling Scholarship was Bryce Mortlock in 1951 who received 400 pounds for travel to Europe to study 'Monumentality and Modern Architecture'. This, at a time when the tallest building in Sydney was the GPO building in Martin Place - finished more than sixty years earlier.

The alumni of scholarship holders since 1951 includes architects recognised in their profession and the broader community, and has included themes that influence the direction of architecture in Australia; including affordable housing, city planning, social trends and social innovation, emerging technologies and methodologies in design and advanced construction.

Hadley's greatest contribution to NSW architecture remains his insistence on the importance of travel in Australian architectural training.

The Byera Hadley Travelling Scholarships enable winners to undertake a course of travel, study, research or other activity approved by the Board, that is seen to contribute to the advancement of architecture.

According to Byera's will, each year the NSW Architects Registration Board awards scholarships to students and graduates of an architecture program in NSW. Reports and resources coming from the Scholarships can be found at architectureinsights.com.au
