Application for temporary registration of overseas architects in New South Wales

Form 03 Architects Act 2003 s16. 18. 20

Notes

The NSW Architects Registration Board may register an individual with an overseas qualification as an architect for a defined, limited period. This temporary registration is not designed for individuals seeking recognition of their overseas qualifications for registration as an architect in Australia and for immigration purposes.

Applications for temporary registration as an overseas architect in NSW must include details of architectural education, registration status from the country of origin and from other registration jurisdiction overseas; and a record of professional employment - in order to assure the NSW Architects Registration Board that the applicant is capable of practising architecture in the NSW with the same level of competence and skills expected of architects with full registration.

Notes

1. Registration as an architect

The applicant for temporary registration must be currently registered or licensed as an architect in a jurisdiction outside Australia. Evidence of current registration/licence must accompany the application. A Certified copy of the current registration or licence must be provided, together with certified English translation if the original document was issued in a language other than English.

2. Appropriate professional experience

Applicants must satisfy the Board that they have completed a minimum of seven years of professional practice as an architect. Experience must be gained in the practice of architecture as articulated in the Australian National Standard of Competency for Architects: Design, Documentation, Project Delivery and Practice Management.

The National Standard of Competency for Architects (NSCA) is available from the Architects Accreditation Council of Australia's website. (AACA) www.aaca.org.au

Applicants must provide a summary of their experience over a minimum of seven years of professional practice and should include details of:

- a. dates and location of each period of employment
- b. position title and description; the nature of the projects worked on (multi-residential, retail, industrial, commercial or other), key responsibilities held and categories of clients (occupier, developer, builder, investor or other give description)
- c. name and contact details of present employer

3. Professional referees

Three professional referee reports testifying to the applicant's competence in the provision of architectural services are also required. At least one of these referee reports should be from a client.

4. Residency status in Australia

This category does not apply to individuals seeking recognition of their overseas qualifications for registration as an architect in Australia in order to gain residency status.

The applicant's passport and visa to Australia must be presented to the Board for verification. The applicant must inform the Board immediately of any change in status/category of his/her visa.

Temporary registration as an overseas architect in NSW will entitle an individual to practise architecture in NSW only.

Each application is considered on a case by case basis, and temporary registration may be renewed at the discretion of the Board, or alternatively, may be withdrawn at any time.





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Extract from the Architects Act 2003 Part 3 Registration Section 18 Temporary registration of overseas architects.

- (1) The Board may register an individual as an architect for a limited period if the Board is satisfied that the:
 - (a) individual is of good fame and character, and
 - (b) individual has architectural qualifications and practical experience in another country of a kind that demonstrates that the individual would be capable of practising architecture in the State with the same level of competence and skills expected of architects with full registration.
- (2) Registration under this section is temporary registration
- (3) A person granted temporary registration is registered as an architect until the temporary registration expires or is cancelled. Temporary registration expires on the date stated in the relevant certificate of registration unless the period of temporary registration is extended.
- (4) The Board may from time to time extend the period for which temporary registration is in force.
- (5) The Board may cancel a person's temporary registration for any reason that the Board considers proper. Cancellation does not affect any application for full registration by that person.
- (6) The Board may impose such conditions as it thinks fit on the temporary registration of a person and may at any time remove, add to or vary those conditions by notice in writing to the registered person.

Process

- 1 Complete Form 03 Application for Temporary Registration of Overseas Architects.
- 2 Subject to documentation being accepted by the Board, applicants will be required to attend an interview.
- 3 Pay the fee of \$735.
- 4 Submit the above to the Registrar, NSW Architects Registration Board at the address below.

Privacy laws and use of this information

The information collected on this form is required by the Architects Act 2003 for the purpose of maintaining a Register of Architects in NSW. Section 26 of the Act requires the Board to publish a Register in such form (whether printed, electronic or both) as the Board may specify from time to time. The Register may be provided to the public and to other registration boards.

Annual renewal fee

Architects in the practising category will pay an annual registration fee of \$285. Annual registration fees are renewed on 30 June each year.

Changes to recorded details

If there is any change to your recorded details, such as a change in contact details, you must inform the Board within 7 days.

Payment methods

You can pay your initial registration fee of \$735 using:

- Visa or MasterCard (use enclosed credit card authorisation form; a merchant surcharge will apply)
- Cheque payable to the NSW Architects Registration Board
- Cash or EFT at the Board's office.
